DISCUSSION OF TAG CHAIR ADVISORY BOARD VOTE

TC172 circulated a resolution to create an advisory board. The wording of the resolution was such that it did not provide an opportunity for the US to have representation on the advisory board. The US TAG voted against the resolution. TC172 Chair, Sven Kiontke has reached out and is working with Dave A. to provide a path for the US to have representation on the advisory board. An official proposal from TC172 leadership to the US TAG to TC172 will be forthcoming.

STATUS REPORTS; PROBLEMS AND PROJECTIONS SUMMARY

Dave A. presented TAG-TC172_Issue_and_Projections-by-SC.pdf

SC1 would like to increase participation from NIST and will continue to focus on bringing US standards practice into the ISO 10110 family.

SC3 continued to meet during pandemic and plans to continue, it remains unclear if an in-person meeting will be schedule in 2021.

SC4 tentatively inquired to the secretariat if ANSI would be an appropriate chair if ASI is unable to continue.

SC5 is seeking additional experts from academia and is continuing active recruitment of experts to support microscopy WG's.

SC6 is seeking further support from industry experts.

SC9 observed a relatively low number of votes (1-4) per ballot for the 30 ballots cast in 2020. SC9 has 19 voting members. They are seeking additional support in increasing participation among members.

Common themes were participation by voting members and/or additional experts are needed.

Michael V. commented the reminder emails detailing the votes received to date sent by Michael Stolberg are helpful. They allow all other members to see who has voted and provide a reminder for the SC leader to follow-up with any relevant experts who haven't voted yet.

Stan S. suggested OEOSC provide a presence on LinkedIn; TC 172 Chair Sven Kiontke has started to post recently with updates and news on TC 172 business, maybe OEOSC could do something similar.

Action - Pat A. to obtain credentials for OEOSC's LinkedIn

ISO has extended the virtual meeting requirement through 2021. 2022 in-person meetings are still not definite; ISO must ensure all global travel is open before resuming in-person meetings as not to exclude any member countries.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

Stan S. made note the cancelation of in-person meetings in 2020 should have saved OEOSC the funds it raised for Sponsorship of the 2020 meetings in Clearwater Florida. Dave A clarified no money was raised in advance of the meetings. Dave A. also noted he has the action to present a sponsorship plan to the OEOSC Board at the next meeting. OEOSC would like to create a list of potential sponsors for when in-person meetings resume.
